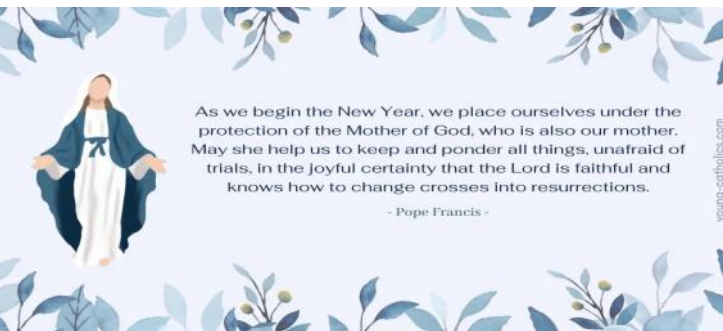

You can change this option at any time. **On your computer:** (you will need a phone that texts): Go to the parish website: [www.wahocatholic.org](http://www.wahocatholic.org) and click on the "Giving" link to set up. Under "Giving Resources" choose "PushPay". It will then send you a text with a code which you will type in to take you to the next step.
